A MOTION, committing Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the Housing Authority of the County of King (HACK) to accomplish the minimum security requirements for rental residential units as set forth in King County Ordinances 8958 and 8959.

WHEREAS, the King County council recognizes the importance of minimum security standards in multi-family buildings, and

WHEREAS, the King County council passed Ordinances 8959 which sets forth requirements for minimum security standards, and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of King has 1,000 rental residential units in unincorporated King County which may not be equipped \$8958 with the minimum security hardware described in Ordinances \$8959 , and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the County of King is concerned about the availability of funding to accomplish a minimum security retrofit project, and

WHEREAS, community development block grant funds can be used for this project;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council agrees to commit community development block grant funds up to a total of \$60,000 to be funded in the program years of 1990 and 1991 to be used for installation of minimum security hardware as
