5 A MOTION authorizing the executive to make

7 approximate amount of \$54,050. to support

11 WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Social and
12 Health Services EMS Section is empowered to make grants to
13 support programs that provide for the training, continuing
14 medical education, certification and recertification of EMS
15 personnel, and

16 WHEREAS, the King County emergency medical services
17 division provides training, continuing medical education,
18 certification and recertification of EMS personnel, and

19 WHEREAS, the council of King County finds that
20 provision of such services is in the public interest;

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King
22 County:

23 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to
24 make application for funds in the approximate amount of
25 \$54,050. to the Washington State Department of Social and
26 Health Services EMS Section to support training, continuing
27 medical education, certification and recertification of EMS
28 personnel on the behalf of King County.

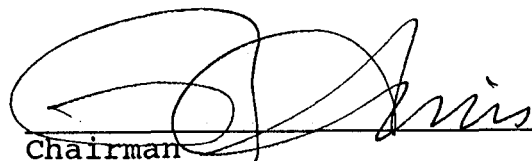
29 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to

31 such contracts as are required by the grantor.

33 enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary
for the implementation of the projects.

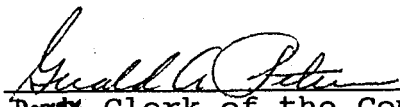
1 D. The Department of Social and Health Services is
