A Motion relating to interim codification of the King County Code

WHEREAS, for a number of years the King County Code has been prepared by the council clerk's office and printed in the county printshop, and

WHEREAS, in house production has saved at least \$30,000 per year over the cost of producing the code under contract with an outside agency and improved the timeliness of its production, and

WHEREAS, the council clerk who has been responsible for directing the codification since the beginning of its production in-house has now retired, and

WHEREAS, the council is now recruiting to fill the Council Clerk position, and

WHEREAS, the new clerk will need to be trained to take over the codification process, and


WHEREAS, the council wishes to maintain timely supplements to the Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council Chair is authorized to execute a contract with Dorothy M. Owens to direct codification of ordinances passed by the council for the period July 1, 1989 through June 30, 1990 at a cost not to exceed \$12,000.
