A MOTION expressing Council support for
City Pride Park Associates and its
Federal Way Urban Nature Park Concept.

WHEREAS, Federal Way is a highly urbanized city in great need
of additional parks and open space, and

WHEREAS, capital projects providing a central focus to the
Federal Way Community are of high value, and

WHEREAS, City Pride Park Associates (CPPA), a non-profit
corporation comprised of Federal Way volunteers, proposes to
bring about the construction of an Urban Nature Park under the
Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) transmission lines, to
extend from the Sea-Tac Mall to the King/Pierce County line, and

WHEREAS, the Urban Nature Park will provide much needed open
space and a central focus to the Federal Way Community, and

WHEREAS, CPPA proposes to build this park without King County
or Federal Way tax money, for the use of all Federal Way
residents and visitors, and

WHEREAS, BPA has issued a letter to CPPA acknowledging and
encouraging the multiple use of the land under their power lines;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The council wishes to express its support for the CPPA Urban
Nature Park Concept. The citizen volunteers comprising City
Pride Park Associates are to be commended for their hard work and
valuable insights in developing the Urban Nature Park Concept.
The council also wishes to encourage the continued cooperation

between CPPA and the Bonneville Power Administration in
developing the multipurpose use of the BPA transmission line
corridor.
