WHEREAS, King County Diking and Drainage District No. 5 was established pursuant to Chapter 115, Laws of 1895, as amended (RCW 85.06) with the original commissioners duly elected as provided by law, and

WHEREAS, in 1984, it was found that vacancies had occurred in all three commissioner positions, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law as then effective, the vacancies on the board of commissioners were filled by the King County Superior Court for terms to expire not later than November 1986, and

WHEREAS, the Washington state legislature, in Chapter 396, Laws of 1985, revised the statutes governing the creation and operation of diking and drainage districts, calling for the establishment of new district governing boards and for altering the terms of office for existing board members, and

WHEREAS, the terms of office of the then commissioners of KCD&D District No. 5 were not altered as called for, and

WHEREAS, the terms of the district commissioners as originally approved expired when due with no elections having been conducted to provide for duly elector successors, thereby legally vacating all three commissioner positions, and

WHEREAS, Section 8, Ch. 396, Laws of 1985 (RCW 85.38.070(4)) provides that when such vacancies occur, the county council shall appoint a district voter to serve in that position until a successor is elected and qualified at the next special district election, as therein provided;
