A MOTION related to Department of Youth Services facilities; approving the Schematic Design for the Youth Services Detention Facility.

WHEREAS, the King County executive and King County council approved an ordinance calling a special election for the purpose of submitting to the voters of King County a proposition to authorize the county to issue its general obligation bonds to provide funds for the acquisition, construction, improving and equipping of youth detention and treatment facilities, and

WHEREAS, King County voters in the November 8, 1988 election approved this proposition, thereby authorizing King County to issue up to \$14,238,000 worth of general obligation bonds to pay for all or part of the costs of acquiring, constructing, improving and equipping youth detention and treatment facilities, and

WHEREAS, the county council approved by Motion 89-218 the Program Plan for the New Juvenile Detention Facility, and

WHEREAS, the Schematic Design for the New Juvenile Detention Facility accords with the project scope, budget and schedule included in the Program Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The schematic design contained in the "King County Department of Youth Services, Youth Services Detention Facility Schematic Design" and dated September 26, 1989, is hereby approved.
