10 WHEREAS, he has been an effective advocate in promoting the  
11 acquisition, development and rehabilitation of park facilities  
12 and enhancing park and recreational opportunities in the East  
13 Sammamish, Eastside and Snoqualmie areas through park capital  
14 improvements including East Sammamish Park, Tolt River-John  
15 MacDonald Park, Marymoor Park, the Clise Mansion and Willowmoor  
16 Historic District, the Preston Snoqualmie Trail, the Snoqualmie  
17 Valley Trail, Three Forks Park, Si View Activity Center, Little  
18 Mount Si, Fall City Community Park, and the Bellevue, Redmond  
19 and Si View Pools, and


20 WHEREAS, he has worked effectively to make sure public park
