2 A MOTION adopting the 1990 Annual Action Plan and
3 authorizing the King County Executive to submit
4 the Plan to the United States Department of Housing
5 and Urban Development.

6 WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended,
7 establishes a program of financial assistance to local governments for
8 the development of viable urban communities through the provision of decent
9 housing and a suitable living environment and expanded economic opportuni-
10 ties, primarily for persons of low and moderate income, and

11 WHEREAS, the Act provides that the Annual Action Plan is the focus
12 for mutual cooperation between local jurisdictions and United States Depart-
13 ment of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) housing programs for carrying
14 out locally determined housing strategies, and

15 WHEREAS, King County is in a consortium with twenty-five cities and
16 towns, and

17 WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Committee has reviewed and approved the
18 Housing Assistance Plan and the Annual Action Plan, required by federal
19 law to be submitted as part of the community development block grant program,
20 and

21 WHEREAS, the King County council has held public hearings to hear
22 the views of citizens on housing and community development needs;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 The 1990 Annual Action Plan is adopted as part of the overall community
25 development program.

26 BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

27 A. The Council of King County finds and determines that this Annual
28 Action Plan reflects current conditions for housing assistance in King
29 County.

30 B. The Council of King County finds and determines that this Annual
31 Action Plan reflects the needs and priorities for housing assistance in
32 King County and that it shall supersede the 1989 Annual Action Plan after
33 adoption by the council and approval by HUD.


1 C. The King County executive is hereby authorized to submit the 1990
2 Annual Action Plan to HUD.

3 D. The King County executive is also authorized to use this Annual
4 Action Plan in reviewing and ranking projects proposed for federal housing
5 assistance under Section 213 of the Housing and Community Development Act
6 of 1974, as amended.

7 E. It is the county's intention that federal housing agencies comply
8 with both the spirit and the letter of the goals and priorities stated
9 in this Housing Assistance Plan and Annual Action Plan when making program
10 allocations and conducting other activities in the county.
