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A MOTION authorizing the transfer of certain county-owned property to the City of Auburn.

WHEREAS, King County owns a certain parcel of property acquired for storm water outfall purposes, and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn has annexed the area into their corporate boundaries, and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn has requested the transfer of the subject property to their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn agrees to manage and maintain the property for drainage purposes, and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be in the best interests of the citizens of King County to execute said transfer, and

WHEREAS, the county council finds that it is no longer necessary for King County to own and manage the subject property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized and directed to execute the necessary documents to effect the transfer of the following described property to the City of Auburn in consideration of the city's commitment to manage and maintain the property for storm drainage purposes and to share with King County 50% of the proceeds from any sale of the subject property. King County's share of the proceeds not to exceed \$4,800.00:

Tax Lot 47, Section 27, Township 21 North, Range 5 East, W.M. - Beginning at intersection of North line of Government Lot 10 with centerline of State Road No. 5; thence Southeasterly along said centerline 36.79 feet; thence Southwesterly at right angles 30 ft. to true beginning; thence Southeasterly along road 101.21 feet; thence S.56-51-00 W. 344.96 ft.; thence Northwesterly at right angles 138 ft.; thence N.56-51-00 E. 291.31 ft. to road; thence Southeasterly 47.08 ft. to True Beginning.
