A MOTION requesting the county executive insure protection of native indian burial grounds consistent with state law.

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Valley Community Plan and Area Zoning was enacted September 5, 1989 by Ordinance 9118, and

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Valley community planning area has a rich historic background, and

WHEREAS, it is one of the traditional and current homelands of the Snoqualmie Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Valley Community Plan recognizes areas within the planning area which are culturally significant, and

WHEREAS, the tribe is concerned about disturbance of burial sites within the planning area, and

WHEREAS, state law adopted in 1989, Substitute Senate Bill No. 5807, requires protection of indian graves and reinternment of disturbed grave sites;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it moved by the Council of King County:

- A. Native indian burial grounds and historic graves are acknowledged to be a finite, irreplaceable, and nonrenewable cultural resource, and are an intrinsic part of the cultural heritage of the people of Washington.
- B. The county executive is hereby requested to insure that as part of development review, indian and historic graves are protected in accordance with the requirements of state law, Revised Code of Washington Chapters 27.44, 27.53 and 68.05 and
