WHEREAS, transfer of title is the result of a land claims agreement between the Puyallup Indian Tribe and local governments in Pierce County, the State of Washington, the United States of America, and certain private property owners, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.C.C. 4.56.080, this property is deemed surplus to King County's interests and needs, and

WHEREAS, authorization by the King County council is needed to transfer this property, thereby conveying clear title of the parcel to the Puyallup Indian Tribe;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to sign the quit claim deed in substantially the form attached, and jointly with Pierce County, transfer title to a portion of the Puyallup River bed as described in the quit claim deed, to the Puyallup Indian Tribe.
