MOTION NO. 7776

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2 A MOTION authorizing the executive to make
3 a grant application for funds in the approximate
4 amount of \$1,524,188 to support a program entitled
5 Outcomes Following Community Interventions for
6 Acute Myocardial Infarction, Grant File No. 928.

7 WHEREAS, The responsibilities of the emergency medical
8 services division as provided for in the King County Code,
9 Chapter 8.64, include improving emergency medical services,
10 analyzing emergency medical service needs, and providing
11 planning for emergency medical services, and

12 WHEREAS, heart disease is the leading cause of death in
13 the United States and in King County, and

14 WHEREAS, medical treatments are now available which can
15 improve paramedics treatment of acute myocardial infarction
16 ("heart attack") if patients recognize symptoms and seek help
17 immediately, and

18 WHEREAS, only 45% of patients currently call 9-1-1 when
19 experiencing heart attack symptoms;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

21 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make
22 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,524,188
23 to the National Center for Health Services Research for support
24 of a three-year project to determine Outcomes Following
25 Community Interventions for Acute Myocardial Infarction;


26 B. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file
27 and execute such applications and enter into and execute such
28 contracts as are required by the grantor;

29 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter
30 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
31 implementation of the project.
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1 D. The National Center for Health Services Research is
2 hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights
3 Act.
