A MOTION to set the date for a hearing on the confirmation of a final revised assessment roll for King county Road Improvement District No. 95.

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance 7081 passed by the King County council on January 7, 1985, established King County Road Improvement District No. 95 ("RID 95"), and

WHEREAS, the construction of the improvement project for which the district was created has now been completed and the total costs and expenses of the project can be predicted with reasonable accuracy, and

WHEREAS, the director of the department of public works has determined the total to be assessed against all parcels therein to be \$530,162.40, and

WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 7081 directed the director of the department of public works, upon determination of the costs of the project to prepare and file with the clerk of the council an assessment roll setting forth that portion of the total costs and expenses of accomplishing the said project which are to be assessed against the property within RID 95 and the amount to be assessed against each parcel therein, and

WHEREAS, the King County Council directed the department of public works to obtain a benefits study to determine the amount of special benefit received by properties as a result of the improvements of RID 95, and

WHEREAS, said benefits study has been completed and the results incorporated into the proposed final assessment roll, and

WHEREAS, the director of the department of public works has prepared and filed said assessment roll:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The council hereby states its intention to hold a public hearing pursuant to RCW 36.88.090 for the purpose of considering the RID 95 assessment roll which is on file with the clerk of the council. Said hearing is scheduled for $\frac{\sqrt{29}}{\sqrt{9}}$, $\frac{1989}{\sqrt{9}}$, at 9:30 a.m in Room 402, King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington.

B. At the hearing, the council will sit as a board of equalization for the purpose of considering said assessment roll, and will consider such written objections as are made thereto, or any part thereof; and at such hearing will correct, revise, raise, lower, change, or modify said roll or any part thereof. Or, the council may set aside said roll and make the assessments de novo so that they are just and equitable, and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

C. The clerk of the council is hereby directed to give notice of the public hearing by mailing and by publication at the times and in the manner set forth in RCW 36.88.090.
