MOTION NO. 7804

A MOTION requesting the Executive to establish a special fee for disposal of waste resulting from flooding.

WHEREAS, King County experienced an abnormal amount of rainfall during the month of January; and

WHEREAS, this rainfall resulted in significant flooding and damage to homes, property and facilities in King County; and

WHEREAS, many property owners who have suffered damage from flooding will need to dispose of waste materials resulting from the flooding; and

WHEREAS, disposal of waste material resulting from flooding will cause financial hardship for many property owners; and

WHEREAS, King County Code 10.12.050 allows the manager of the division of solid waste to authorize an exception to the payment of disposal fees for users who are engaged in a community litter clean-up campaign; and

WHEREAS, the community of King County will also benefit from cleanup of damage caused by flooding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Executive is hereby requested to authorize an exception to the payment of disposal fees in excess of \$6.50 per load for the disposal by non-commercial parties at King County solid waste handling facilities of waste material created by flooding, or in excess of \$47.00 per load for non-commercial vehicles larger than pickup trucks. This exception shall be authorized only until February 4, 1990.
