5 A MOTION authorizing the county executive to
6 accept a gift of two used passenger vans with
7 an approximate total value of \$20,000 from the
8 State of Washington Department of Social and
9 Health Services

10 WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services
11 Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has selected King County to receive a
12 gift of two Ford passenger vans, and

13 WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services
14 Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has delivered said vehicles to the King
15 County garage, and

16 WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services
17 Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has recommended two local agencies,
18 Community Enterprises of Issaquah and with Mobile Crew North, to use the vans,
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the King County department of human services contracts with
21 Community Enterprises of Issaquah and with Mobile Crew North to provide
22 employment services to persons with developmental disabilities and the
23 agencies have immediate need for the vans to transport workers with
24 disabilities to job sites, and

25 WHEREAS, King County will be given title of the vans and will have full
26 authority regarding their future use and eventual disposal, and

27 WHEREAS, citizens of King County with developmental disabilities will
28 benefit from acceptance of the gift, and

29 WHEREAS, the proposed use of the gift is consistent with the King County
30 Developmental Disabilities 1989-91 Biennial Plan.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

32 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to accept the gift of
33 two vans from the Department of Social and Health Services Division of
Vocational Rehabilitation.
