A MOTION authorizing the county executive to accept a gift of two used passenger vans with an approximate total value of \$20,000 from the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has selected King County to receive a gift of two Ford passenger vans, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has delivered said vehicles to the King County garage, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation has recommended two local agencies, Community Enterprises of Issaquah and with Mobile Crew North, to use the vans, and

WHEREAS, the King County department of human services contracts with Community Enterprises of Issaquah and with Mobile Crew North to provide employment services to persons with developmental disabilities and the agencies have immediate need for the vans to transport workers with disabilities to job sites, and

WHEREAS, King County will be given title of the vans and will have full authority regarding their future use and eventual disposal, and

WHEREAS, citizens of King County with developmental disabilities will benefit from acceptance of the gift, and

WHEREAS, the proposed use of the gift is consistent with the King County Developmental Disabilities 1989-91 Biennial Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to accept the gift of two vans from the Department of Social and Health Services Division of Vocational Rehabilitation.
