A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to submit an application for funding to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Emergency Shelter Grants Program.

WHEREAS, the federal government through the adoption and administration of Subtitle B of the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Act of 1987 will make \$73,200,000 of 1990 Emergency Shelter Grants Program funds available nationwide, and

WHEREAS, King County as an urban county is entitled to \$110,000, and

WHEREAS, the federal government through the regulations for the Emergency Shelter Grants Program requires King County to submit an application for the funds to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and

WHEREAS, emergency shelter facilities will be physically improved, and

WHEREAS, emergency shelter service will be improved through additional operating funds and expanded services provided;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to submit a 1990 program application to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Emergency Shelter Grants Program.
