## MOTION NO. 7873

A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to create Road Improvement District No. 118 for street lights in the plat of Meadowland East.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County council requesting the creation of a road improvement district for providing electric energy, maintenance and operation to existing ornamental street lights, and

WHEREAS, the director of the department of public works has determined that said petition has been signed by owners of an aggregate amount of the majority of the linear frontage upon the improvement to be made, and of an aggregate amount of the majority of the area within the limits of the assessment district to be created therefor, and that the improvement appears to be feasible, and that the benefits appear to exceed the cost of the improvement, and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found that said petition is sufficient and that the proposed district is sufficiently developed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. It is the intention of the council to establish, pursuant to the aforesaid petition and pursuant to Chapter 36.88 RCW, a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 118" (hereinafter "RID 118"). It is intended that RID 118 shall include all the territory described as follows:

all of that area within the plat of Meadowland East as recorded in Volume 143 pages 34-36 King County record of plats.

B. It is further the intention of the council to order the improvement of those portions of the following described streets within RID 118 by providing the installation, electric energy, maintenance and operation to street lights:

> 122nd Place Southeast, 123rd Place Southeast and 124th Avenue Southeast all within or adjacent to the plat of Meadowlands East.

Said improvements are hereafter sometimes referred to collectively as the "project."

C. The total cost and expense of the project which is to be borne by all of the property owners within RID 118 is now estimated to be \$17.22 per lot for the first year and \$15.80 per lot for each succeeding year. These costs are based on a King County office of finance fee of \$5.00 per account to be assessed the first year, a King County department of public works fee of \$1.50 per account per year and a Puget Sound Power & Light Company fee of \$8.34 per month per light. The final amount of said costs and expense to be borne by said property owners will be determined each year, will be assessed against the benefited private property within the district, with such assessment levied on the basis of equal assessment for each platted building lot. Actual assessments may vary from assessment estimates so long as those actual assessments do not exceed a figure equal to the increased true and fair value the improvement adds to the property.

D. All persons who wish to object to or to otherwise be heard on the creation of proposed Road Improvement District No. 118 described herein, on the accomplishment of the project described herein, or on the assessment of their property for the cost and expenses of accomplishing the project in the manner described herein, are hereby notified to appear and present their objections or testimony at an open public meeting of the King County council to be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, at 9:30 a.m. on the <u>1th</u> day of <u>May</u>, 19<u>90</u>. At such time an place, the council intends to hear such objections and testimony and to act on the intention set forth herein.

E. The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said public hearing by publication and by mailing at the times and in the manner described in RCW 36.88.050.

F. The director of the department of public works is hereby directed to submit to the council at, or prior to, the date fixed for said hearing, a diagram or print showing thereon the lots, tracts, and parcels of land and other property which will be specially benefited thereby, and the estimated amount of the cost and expense of said improvement to be borne by each lot, tract, or parcel of land or other property, and also designating thereon all property which is being purchased under contract from the county.
