A MOTION establishing April 21-22, 1990 as Earth Day(s) in King County.

WHEREAS, we are all part of the global community and as such all of our environmental decisions affect everyone on the globe, and

WHEREAS, Earth Day 1990 is the 20th anniversary of the original Earth Day on April 22, 1970, and

WHEREAS, King County has been a leader in protecting the environment with its recycling program; the recently adopted land use plans in Bear Creek and Snoqualmie; the Comprehensive Plan; the early recognition and adoption of the Sensitive Areas ordinance and the pursuit of revisions of the Sensitive Areas ordinance to reflect our increased knowledge of ecosystems; the Open Space and agricultural preservation plans; the ground water management areas; the basin planning program and surface water management utility, and

WHEREAS, public awareness is an important part of the battle to eliminate the problems our environment is facing, and

WHEREAS, Earth Day will be celebrated this year on April 21 and 22, 1990 in Marymoor Park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County that April 21-22, 1990 are hereby declared EARTH DAYS in King County.
