A MOTION requesting the King County Executive to recognize the mutual and offsetting benefit of developing a library on a county owned property at Richmond Beach Center Park and to develop a general policy of mutual and offsetting benefit.

WHEREAS, King County owns a significant amount of real property purchased for public benefit for which there are no plans to develop for public use, and

WHEREAS, rapidly escalating values and demand for property require efficient and effective use of public land, and

WHEREAS, other jurisdictions and government agencies may have need to site, on county owned land, public facilities that provide vital and important services to the community, and

WHEREAS, any public facility constructed on county owned land must be compatible and consistent with the commitments and obligations which encumber the county to the property, and

WHEREAS, the development of such a public facility would include amenities and improvements of enough significance to the county and its citizens to provide a mutual and offsetting benefit in lieu of obtaining fair market value reimbursement for use of the land, and

WHEREAS, the King County Library System has proposed developing a library on county owned property at the Richmond Beach Center Park, and

WHEREAS, under certain circumstances a library sited on park property will provide recreational benefits that allow users to enjoy both park and library services on the same visit, and

WHEREAS, the library system is proposing to provide park enhancements, amenities and public meeting facilities that will provide a significant mutual and offsetting benefit to the county, and
