A MOTION in which the King County Council recognizes and shows appreciation to the members of the EARTH FAIR 90 Coalition.

WHEREAS, the Coalition numbers more than 60 organizations and individuals from the public and private sectors who have worked for the common goal of making people aware of the need to preserve and improve our environment by organizing and promoting EARTH FAIR 90, and

WHEREAS, the main mission of EARTH FAIR 90 is to heighten the environmental awareness of Puget Sound citizens; provoke them into action; celebrate environmental achievements since the first EARTH DAY twenty years ago, and to accomplish this in an entertaining and enjoyable environment, and

WHEREAS, EARTH FAIR 90 demonstrates the successful coordination and cooperation among government agencies, business interests, and nonprofit environmental agencies, and

WHEREAS, many organizations and businesses have contributed the funds and personnel necessary to organize and support a celebration of this magnitude, and

WHEREAS, 75,000 people are expected to attend EARTH FAIR 90 at Marymoor Park in Redmond on Saturday and Sunday, April 21 - 22;
