A MOTION authorizing the county executive to execute an agreement under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Revised Code of Washington Chapter 39.34 whereby the department of public safety will provide law enforcement service to the City of Skykomish.

WHEREAS, King County has traditionally been willing to assist cities within its jurisdiction when called upon to do so, and

WHEREAS, the City of Skykomish is desirous of contracting with the county for law enforcement service for the calendar year 1990, and

WHEREAS, King County has for years past contracted with certain cities within its jurisdiction for full police service, and

WHEREAS, King County is desirous of continuing such traditional rendition of service under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, RCW Chapter 39.34;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute an interlocal agreement, substantially in the form attached, with the City of Skykomish to provide police service for the calendar year 1990.

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INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

This is an Agreement between King County, a charter county government under the constitution and laws of the State of Washington, hereinafter referred to as "the County," and the City of Skykomish, a corporation under the Laws of the State of Washington formed for municipal purposes, hereinafter referred to as "the City." This agreement is intended to be effective on the date of execution by both parties until 31 December 1990, and to be renewable thereafter by mutual written agreement of parties. It supersedes any prior contract between the parties relating to the same subject matter. It may be terminated during its term only after 60 days written notice received by one party, given by the other. It is intended to express the entire agreement of the parties, and may not be altered or modified in any way unless such modification is reduced to writing, signed by both parties, and affixed to this original agreement. Any termination of this agreement shall not terminate any duty of either party matured prior to such termination.

The City has geographical boundaries entirely contained within those of the County, and said City has power, authority and responsibility to provide police protection for its citizens within its boundaries. The County has established and maintains a Department of Public Safety which routinely provides law enforcement services to the citizens of unincorporated King County. The County is capable of extending law enforcement service into the geographical area under the jurisdiction of the City. The City is desirous of obtaining law enforcement service from the County to fulfill its obligation to its citizens, pursuant to RCW 39.34.010 and 39.34.080.

For the purpose of this agreement:

"Law enforcement service" means routine police patrol within the geographical boundaries of the City, to provide enforcement of

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32 33 State law and City ordinances as well as a deterrent and preventive effect against criminal activity. Such service expressly encompasses those unusual and additional involving the investigation of crimes, including but not to investigation by personnel assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division of the County Department of Public Safety, photographic and other scientific resources organic to that Department. This also includes such services necessary testifying in court. It does not include detention and correction services.

In consideration for the promises of the County hereinafter set forth, the City promises to:

- 1. Pay to the County at the beginning of each month during which this agreement is in effect the amount of nine hundred, eighty-six dollars (\$986.00);
- 2. Confer municipal police authority on such County officers as might be engaged hereunder in enforcing City ordinances within City boundaries, for the purposes of carrying out this agreement;
- 3. To the extent reasonably possible with all due consideration for local circumstances, bring local ordinances into conformity with County ordinances or State law, the better to provide uniformity of regulation and enforcement throughout the County;
- 4. Supply at its own cost and expenses any special supplies, stationery, notices, forms, and the like where such must be issued in the name of the City.

In consideration for the promises of the City hereinbefore set forth and payment of the sum specified above, the County promises to:

1. Provide law enforcement service within the geographical boundaries of the City, rendering such service of the same level, degree and type as is customarily provided by the County in its

4. Furnish all personnel and any and all other things necessary to accomplish the levels of law enforcement service hereinbefore described.

Both parties understand and agree that the County is acting hereunder as an independent contractor, with the intended following results:

- 1. Control of personnel, standards of performance, discipline, and all other aspects of performance shall be governed entirely by the County;
- 2. All persons rendering service hereunder shall be for all purposes employees of the County, although they may from time to time act as commissioned officers of the City;
- The County will protect, defend, indemnify and save harmless the City, its officers, employees and agents from any and all costs, claims, judgments or awards of damages, resulting from negligent acts or omissions of the County, its officers, employees, or agents. In executing this agreement, the County does assume liability or responsibility for or in any way release not liability or responsibility which arises in the City from any whole or in part from the existence or effect of city ordinances, regulations. If any cause, claim, suit, action or rules or administrative proceeding is commenced in which the enforceability and/or validity of any such City ordinance, rule or regulation is at issue, the City shall defend the same at its sole expense and and if judgment is entered or damages are awarded against the

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including all chargeable costs and attorney's fees. 4. The City will protect, defend, indemnify, and harmless the County, its officers, employees, and agents from any

City, the County, or both, the City shall satisfy the same,

all costs, claims, judgments, or awards of damages, arising out of or in any way resulting from the negligent acts or

omissions of the City, its officers, employees, or agents.

The County hereby certifies that it is an equal opportunity employer and has developed and implemented an Affirmative Action Program in accordance with the guidelines contained in Revised Order 4 of the U.S. Department of Labor. Both parties agree that they will not discriminate against any employee or applicant employment because of race, color, religion, sex, or national origin. Both parties agree that they will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, sex, or national origin. Such action includes, but religion, not limited to employment, upgrading, demotion, or transfer, recruitment or recruitment advertising, layoff or termination, rates of pay or other forms of compensation, or selection for training, including apprenticeship.

Both parties understand that no significant impact on the environment will result from services rendered hereunder.
