MOTION NO. 7900

A MOTION relating to the conveyance of county road rights of-way in the vicinity of Cedar Grove Park to the State of Washington for the purpose of improving State Route 169.

WHEREAS, King County is the record owner of the following described lands:

All county road rights-of-way lying within the project limits of State Route 169, and

WHEREAS, in the improvement of State Route 169 by the State of Washington, Department of Transportation, it is necessary and advisable for the State of Washington to acquire title to these lands for a right-of-way for said highway, and

WHEREAS, after due consideration, the council of King County deems it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of King County and the State of Washington that King County convey said county road rights-of-way to the State of Washington by Quit Claim Deed for a consideration of mutual benefits;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to execute, on behalf of the citizens of King County, the necessary instruments in order to convey the rights-of-way described as follows, and delivery of the same to the State of Washington:

All county road rights-of-way lying within the project limits of SR 169, Cedar Grove Road vicinity to Cedar Grove Park vicinity, also being located in Sections 19, 29, and 30, Township 23 North, Range 6 East, W. M., the specific details concerning all of which are to be found within that certain map of definite location now of record and on file in the office of the Secretary of Transportation at Olympia and bearing date of approval March 14, 1986, revised February 23, 1989, sheets 6 and 7 of 9 sheets, TOGETHER WITH all appurtenances thereto, and

PASSED this 16th day of April, 19 90.
