12 WHEREAS, King County is a member of the King County Community  
13 Development Block Grant Consortium, and

14 WHEREAS, King County as the official applicant is responsible  
15 to the federal government for all activities undertaken in the  
16 King County Consortium with Community Development Block Grant  
17 funds, and

18 WHEREAS, federal Community Development Block Grant  
19 legislation requires King County to adopt an annual community  
20 development plan to guide the use of Community Development Block  
21 Grant funds and identify community development and housing needs,  
22 and

23 WHEREAS, the 1991 King County Community Development Block  
24 Grant Consortium Policy Plan (hereinafter referred to as the 1991  
25 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan) meets the federal Community  
26 Development Block Grant requirements for an annual plan for the  
27 year January 1, 1991 to December 31, 1991, and

28 WHEREAS, King County Consortium members have participated in  
29 the development of the 1991 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan through  
30 review and comment, and

31 WHEREAS, the Consortium's Joint Policy Committee endorsed the  
32 1991 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan, including the administrative  
33 setaside;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The attached 1991 CDBG Consortium Policy Plan including the administrative setaside, and the 1991 Local Program Policies for the Pass-through Cities and for the County and Small Cities fund, including the regional earmarks, are hereby adopted to guide the planning and development of the 1991 CDBG Program, provided that King County Council adoption of Renton's Program Policies are subject to approval by the Renton City Council.

B. All eligible applications shall be given consideration.
