3 A MOTION related to determining whether additional King  
4 County permanent jail capacity is necessary, if so, how such  
5 need may be met, and preparation of a phased environmental  
6 review.

7 WHEREAS, in the provision of any necessary jail capacity, the King County  
8 executive and King County council need to agree on a schedule and process, and

9 WHEREAS, the executive will develop an operational master plan and a facil-  
10 ity master plan to provide information from which King County can decide whether  
11 additional permanent jail capacity beyond present levels is necessary, and if  
12 so, how that capacity should be provided, and

13 WHEREAS, there is a high level of community interest in the preparation and  
14 review of the operational and facility master plans and King County's  
15 consideration of whether additional permanent jail capacity is necessary and, if  
16 so, how this should be provided, and

17 WHEREAS, State Environmental Protection Act (SEPA) guidelines, WAC Chapter  
18 197-11, allow environmental review to be phased so as to assist agencies and the  
19 public to a focus on issues that require thorough assessment prior to a  
20 decision, and

21 WHEREAS, SEPA procedures provide a process for public comment upon the scope  
22 and content of environmental review for the county's decision making process  
23 regarding permanent additional jail capacity; and

24 WHEREAS, the King County executive is proposing a schedule for two phases of  
25 review: 1) submittal of an operational master plan and a facility master plan  
26 followed by 2) potential site identification, evaluation and recommendation on  
27 selection (Attachments A and B, incorporated by reference herein), and

28 WHEREAS, the King County executive has presented a preliminary schedule to  
29 the King County council, the City of Seattle, and suburban jurisdictions for  
30 review and comment by May 21, 1990.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

32 The executive is requested to prepare and transmit the following no later  
33

1 than May 30, 1990:

2 1. An operational master plan to address the question of whether permanent  
3 additional jail capacity is necessary beyond present levels.

4 2. A final schedule, scope of work and budget for preparation of the  
5 facility master plan and EIS in order to decide what the options are for provid-  
6 ing permanent additional jail capacity, types of facility, and criteria recom-  
7 mended to be used for potential site selection. The preparation of  
8 environmental review documents is to be prepared in two phases to coincide with  
9 this schedule. The EIS should discuss probable significant adverse environ-  
10 mental impacts and reasonable alternatives, including mitigation, as determined  
11 by the EIS scoping process.

12 3. A motion for concurrence of the King County Council to hire an EIS con-  
13 sultant on an emergency basis and an ordinance appropriating sufficient funds to  
14 conduct the environmental review.

Summary of Proposed Schedule

1. OMP transmitted to Council (need for additional capacity beyond present levels) 5/28/90
2. Threshold determination by lead agency (DAD) 5/28/90
3. Contents of FMP, including options for providing additional jail capacity, types of facilities, and criteria to be used for potential site selection. 5/28/90
4. Organize/train FMP workgroups 6/11/90
5. King County Council acts on OMP no later than this date 7/02/90
6. EIS Scope completed by no later than this date 7/02/90
7. FMP work and EIS review begin 7/02/90
8. FMP and Phase I FEIS transmitted to Council 12/01/90
9. King County Council acts on FMP no later than this date 12/30/90
10. Begin Phase II: Land search, site identification, evaluation, and recommendation on selection along with environmental review documents 12/30/90
11. Facility Program Plan to Council 4/30/91
12. Recommended sites transmitted to King County Council along with draft environmental review documents 4/30/91
13. King County Council decides on site selection no later than this date 10/30/91

NOTE: Opportunity for public input is either through the legislative process or through a combination of legislative process and environmental review. By May 30, 1990 the Executive will submit to the Council a detailed schedule of opportunities for public involvement throughout the process.
