A MOTION requesting the King County Open Space Oversight Committee to review and recommend a plan for expenditure of the local option real estate excise tax for open space acquisition and requesting the King County executive to provide the necessary staff resources to assist the Committee.

WHEREAS the Washington State Legislature, by passage of Substitute Senate Bill 6639, has authorized counties to submit for voter approval a 1 percent real estate excise tax of up to 1 percent dedicated to the acquisition and maintenance of open space lands, and

WHEREAS, by the overwhelming passage of the 1989 Open Space Bond measure the voters of King County declared their commitment to acquiring and preserving our diminishing open space resources, and

WHEREAS, the authority outlined in Substitute Senate Bill 6639 provides King County with the unique and timely ability to acquire remaining open space within its boundaries and preserve for future generations our environment and quality of life, and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to acquire open space with revenues derived from a tax generated by growth and inflation of property values which combine to threaten open space, and

WHEREAS, this authority is available to all Washington State counties and presents an opportunity for King County to join with its neighboring jurisdictions in the Puget Sound region to create a comprehensive open space system unparalleled in this nation, and

WHEREAS, the dramatic growth this region is experiencing and the unprecedented increase in land values makes it imperative that we take immediate, decisive and unprecedented action to preserve the natural heritage of our great Pacific Northwest;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County Open Space Citizens Oversight

Committee is requested to review and recommend to the King County council and the King County executive, by July 1, 1990 a plan for expenditure of up to 1 percent real estate excise tax for the acquisition and maintenance of open space.

- This plan shall be developed in consultation with the B. cities of King County and with the benefit of public input.
- The plan shall provide for sunsetting this taxing authority and shall review the question of whether affordable housing transactions can legally be exempted.
- The plan shall recommend methods to exempt affordable housing transactions from the tax if legal and constitutional.
- The Citizens Oversight Committee is further directed to explore the interest of other Puget Sound counties in developing a coordinated ballot measure for submittal to the voters.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

The King County executive is requested to join with the county council in providing sufficient staff resources to the Citizens Oversight Committee to perform the assigned task.
