A MOTION showing the appreciation of
the King County Council for the
dedication and outstanding service of
the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

WHEREAS, agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation
(F.B.I.) recently averted acts of terrorism which could have
resulted in numerous deaths and personal injury involving
citizens and destruction of property in the Puget Sound area, and

WHEREAS, through their vigilance, diligence and perseverance,
agents of the F.B.I. were able to interdict members of the Aryan
Nations prior to their performance of acts of terrorism planned
to occur in King County earlier this month, and

WHEREAS, The counter-terrorist division of the F.B.I. works
cooperatively and interacts closely with law enforcement officers
on the municipal, county, state, national and international
levels to protect the safety of people and property throughout
the world, and

WHEREAS, the manner in which the F.B.I. agents must work
often precludes any recognition or appreciation for risking their
lives on a daily basis and for painstakingly following through on
minute details of investigations in the interest of the public
they protect, and

1 NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Moved: The Council joins the people of
2 King County in expressing gratitude and appreciation for the
3 outstanding services performed by agents of the Federal Bureau of
4 Investigation in the recent and highly successful interdiction of
5 the Aryan Nations terrorists in our area.
