A MOTION endorsing the preservation of the Interstate 90 Greenway and supporting the Mountains to Sound March July 4 through July 8, 1990.

WHEREAS, there exists a concept of a greenway corridor along Interstate 90 to link and preserve in their natural state wilderness areas, farmlands, public parks and open space, and

WHEREAS, the Issaquah Alps Trails Club and the Snoqualmie Valley Trails Club are sponsoring the Mountains to Sound March beginning on July 4 and ending July 8, 1990, and

WHEREAS, King County, the State of Washington and the suburban cities have acquired large portions of Cougar, Squak, and Tiger Mountains and have a continuing interest in preserving additional open space lands in the Interstate 90 corridor and throughout the region;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County Council endorses the concept of preserving the Interstate 90 greenway and supports the Mountains to Sound March from July 4 to July 8, 1990.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED, The King County Council commends the Issaquah Alps Trails Club and the Snoqualmie Valley Trails Club for sponsoring this event as a way to inform the public on the need to preserve the natural areas and open spaces along the Interstate 90 corridor.
