## MOTION NO. 7963

A MOTION authorizing King County to enter into an agreement with Soos Creek Water & Sewer District for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system in Council District 9.

WHEREAS, Soos Creek Water and Sewer District has filed an application for a franchise to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system to serve the Tahoma School District No. 409 only in accordance with R.C.W. 36.55.010, and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Technical Review Committee, on February 21, 1990, recommended that this franchise be approved in conjunction with the district's comprehensive plan amendment and Soos Creek's community plan amendment of its local service area boundaries, and

WHEREAS, this franchise will help to resolve Shadow Lake and Cedar River Elementary Schools' sewage disposal failures by connecting to the district's proposed sanitary sewer system, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle-King County health department has designated the septic tank drainfields for the shcool site as public hazards and supports the school district's solution to connect to the sanitary sewer system, and

WHEREAS, the sewer main between Soos Creek Water and Sewer District's system and the Cedar River and Shadow Lake Elementary Schools shall not be available for any other connections unless such connection is consistent with the Tahoma/Raven Heights Community Plan, and

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the relevant county executive departments for review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The granting of a franchise to Soos Creek Water and Sewer District to construct, operate and maintain a sewer system within King County is hereby The county executive is authorized to enter into and execute the sewer approved. system franchise, which by this reference is fully incorporated herein as part of the motion. Said franchise is granted to the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District to expire on April 1, 2000, concurrent with their Franchises 7600 and 6234. Said franchise shall include all of the general and special conditions required by the . county

If within 30 days after the granting of this franchise, the applicant shall have failed to sign the written acceptance incorporated herein, then the herein rights and privileges granted shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be null and void.
