A MOTION requesting the Executive to designate a site for a climbing structure at Marymoor Park and present a budget estimate for this project by August 15, 1990.

WHEREAS, a large number of residents of King County participate in the sport of rock and mountain climbing, and

WHEREAS, education and training in climbing techniques significantly reduce the risk of injury in this sport, and

WHEREAS, climbing structures are an essential part of a good training program, and

WHEREAS, only two of these structures are located in all of King County and both of these are located in Seattle, and

WHEREAS, a climbing structure on the east side is badly needed, and

WHEREAS, Marymoor Park is accessible to climbers anywhere on the Eastside and a structure can easily be located within this park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Executive is requested to designate a site for a climbing structure at Marymoor Park and to present a budget for this project by August 15, 1990.
