A MOTION authorizing the release of \$20,000 in reserve funds to the King County Community Services Division for consultant feasibility work towards developing two confidential shelters for domestic violence victims outside of Seattle.

WHEREAS, King County has recognized domestic violence services as a high priority through funding for domestic violence services and significant involvement in ongoing planning efforts, and

WHEREAS, the need for confidential shelters in south and east county has been an identified unmet need by King County, the Human Services Roundtable, and the United Way, and,

WHEREAS, the Human Services Roundtable has prioritized domestic violence services through a regional family violence planning project aiming to develop a coordinated regional approach to meeting the needs of families experiencing violence and abuse, and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Roundtable planning process is continuing over the next few months, and

WHEREAS, there is a reserve fund in the county's Housing Opportunity Fund that is available on October 1, 1990, and

WHEREAS, Eastside Domestic Violence Program and Domestic Abuse Women's Network are community based domestic violence agencies who lack the staff and resources to carry out technical feasibility work necessary to access the Housing Opportunity Fund, and

WHEREAS, the community services division wishes to provide funds to the domestic violence agencies in order to apply for the Housing Opportunity Funds for capital costs associated with developing the shelters;
