

MOTION NO. 8034

A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to create Road Improvement District No. 121 for street lights in the plat of Rosemary Glen and setting the date for a public hearing.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County council requesting the creation of a road improvement district to provide electric energy to and maintain and operate existing ornamental street lights, and

WHEREAS, the director of the department of public works has determined that said petition has been signed by owners of a majority of the linear frontage upon the improvement to be made, and of an aggregate amount of the majority of the area within the limits of the assessment district to be created therefor, and that the improvement appears to be feasible, and that the benefits appear to exceed the cost of the improvement, and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found that said petition is sufficient and that the proposed district is sufficiently developed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. It is the intention of the council to establish, pursuant to the aforesaid petition and pursuant to Chapter 36.88 RCW, a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 121" (hereinafter "RID 121"). It is intended that RID 121 shall include all the territory described as follows:

that area within the boundary of the plat of Rosemary Glen as recorded in King County plats volume 152 pages 34-39 recording number 9005080709.

B. It is further the intention of the council to order the improvement of those portions of the following described streets within RID 121 to provide electric energy to and maintain and operate street lights:

97th Avenue South, 96th Place South, and South 228th Street all within the plat of Rosemary Glen.

Said improvements are hereafter sometimes referred to collectively as the "project."

1 C. The total cost and expense of the project which is to be borne by  
2 all of the property owners within RID 121 is now estimated to be \$33.58 per  
3 lot for the first year and \$28.58 per lot for each succeeding year. These  
4 costs are based on a King County office of finance fee of \$5.00 per account  
5 to be assessed the first year, a King County department of public works fee  
6 of \$1.50 per account per year and a Puget Sound Power & Light Company fee of  
7 \$8.84 per month per light. The final amount of said costs and expense to be  
8 borne by said property owners will be determined each year, will be assessed  
9 against the benefited private property within the district, with such  
10 assessment levied on the basis of equal assessment for each platted building  
11 lot. Actual assessments may vary from assessment estimates so long as those  
12 actual assessments do not exceed a figure equal to the increased true and  
13 fair value the improvement adds to the property.

14 D. All persons who wish to object to or to otherwise be heard on the  
15 creation of proposed Road Improvement District No. 121 described herein, on  
16 the accomplishment of the project described herein, or on the assessment of  
17 their property for the cost and expenses of accomplishing the project in the  
18 manner described herein, are hereby notified to appear and present their  
19 objections or testimony at an open public meeting of the King County council  
20 to be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington,  
21 at 9:30 a.m. on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1990. At such  
22 time and place, the council intends to hear such objections and testimony  
23 and to act on the intention set forth herein.

24 E. The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to give  
25 notice of said public hearing by publication and by mailing at the times and  
26 in the manner described in RCW 36.88.050.

27 F. The director of the department of public works is hereby directed  
28 to submit to the council at, or prior to, the date fixed for said hearing, a  
29 diagram or print showing thereon the lots, tracts, and parcels of land and  
30 other property which will be specially benefited thereby, and the estimated  
31 amount of the cost and expense of said improvement to be borne by each lot,  
32 tract, or parcel of land or other property, and also designating thereon all  
33 property which is being purchased under contract from the county.

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G. "Costs and expenses of accomplishing the Project," as used herein, shall mean those costs and expenses described in RCW 36.88.300.
