2 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive  
3 to enter into agreements with the Washington  
4 State Department of Ecology regarding the joint  
5 funding of plans and projects to work with  
6 community groups to improve water quality in  
7 King County pursuant to Chapter 70.146 R.C.W.

8 WHEREAS, the Washington State legislature has created the Centennial  
9 Clean Water Fund for the joint funding of water quality improvement plans  
10 and projects with other public agencies in the state pursuant to  
11 Chapter 70.146.R.C.W., and

12 WHEREAS, the Washington State legislature has adopted the 1987 and  
13 1989 Puget Sound Water Quality Management Plans that require local govern-  
14 ments to conduct certain planning and implementation activities related to  
15 preserving or improving water quality in Puget Sound and in waters tribu-  
16 tary to Puget Sound, and

17 WHEREAS, a primary mission of the surface water management program  
18 is to work with citizens and community groups to protect King County's nat-  
19 ural drainage systems, and

20 WHEREAS, the King County department of public works, surface water  
21 management division, has applied for and been offered Centennial Clean  
22 Water Fund grants by the Washington State Department of Ecology to develop  
23 and coordinate a stream stewardship program, and

24 WHEREAS, state requirements include a twenty-five percent local match  
25 for all categories of grant moneys received, and

26 WHEREAS, an effective citizen monitoring and education program must  
27 be developed to address nonpoint source pollution and to ensure local care  
28 of streams, wetlands, lakes, and rivers, and,

29 WHEREAS, a trained and reliable network of citizens and businesses  
30 would significantly strengthen and expand King County's current surface  
31 water management program;
