A MOTION authorizing application for Federal Surplus Property to the United States Department of the Interior as provided by the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended.

WHEREAS, certain real property owned by the United States, located in King County, State of Washington, has been declared surplus and at the discretion of the General Services Administration, may be assigned to the Secretary of the Interior for disposal for public park and recreation purposes, under the provisions of Section 203(k)(2) of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 (63 Stat. 387), as amended, and rules and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, more particularly described as follows:

1. Maple Valley Heights Park located at 192nd Avenue Southeast and Southeast 164th Street, King County, State of Washington.
2. 9-B-WA-987
3. 13.3651 acres, and

WHEREAS, King County needs and will utilize said property in perpetuity for a public park as set forth in its application and in accordance with the requirements of said act and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED, by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to make formal application to the Secretary of the Interior for and secure the transfer to King County of the above mentioned property for said use upon and subject to such exceptions, reservations, restrictions as the Secretary of the Interior, or his authorized representative, may require in connection with the disposal of said property under said Act and the rules and regulations issued pursuant thereto:
