A MOTION authorizing the executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$173,665 to support development of a regional emergency medical services and trauma care system.

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature adopted the Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care Systems Act in order to promote a system of emergency medical services and trauma care, and

WHEREAS, an efficient and well coordinated emergency medical services and trauma care system can reduce costs and the incidence of inappropriate and inadequate patient care, and minimize the human suffering and costs associated with preventable mortality and morbidity, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Health, Office of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) and Trauma Systems is authorized to make grants to support development of a regional EMS and trauma care system, and

WHEREAS, the Seattle King County Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Care Council has endorsed a proposal for the King County Emergency Medical Services Division to receive funding from the State and to perform activities on behalf of the EMS and Trauma Care Council related to the development of a regional emergency medical services and trauma care system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$173,665 to the Washington State Department of Health, Office of EMS and Trauma Systems to support development of a regional emergency medical services and trauma care system on behalf of King County.
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
