A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate $\,$ amount of \$400,000 to support a pilot program for collection and composting of food and yard waste in King County and for testing of resultant compost products.

WHEREAS, King County has adopted a goal of reducing and recycling the waste stream by sixty-five percent by the year 2000, and

WHEREAS, food and yard waste represent a substantial amount of the county waste stream that could potentially be converted into usable compost products, and

WHEREAS, research is needed regarding food waste collection, composting, and the resultant compost product quality in order to assess the feasibility of food waste composting in King County, and

WHEREAS, research is needed regarding on-site composting of food and yard waste at businesses and institutions, and

WHEREAS, research is needed to test the alternatives for on-site residential food waste composting, and

WHEREAS, Section 97 of Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1671, the Waste Not Washington Act, provides for the award of grants to establish the feasibility of composting food and yard waste, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology has established a grant category for collection, processing and testing of compost with a matching requirement from local governments of twenty-five percent for projects using food waste and forty percent for projects using yard waste, and

WHEREAS, the council of King County recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of about \$170,000 as a required cash match in support of this program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The county executive is hereby authorized to make application to the Department of Ecology for funds in the approximate amount of \$400,000 for a pilot food and yard waste collection, processing, and testing program on behalf of King County;
