A MOTION calling for the meeting of the district court districting committee for the purpose of amending the King County District Court districting plan to allow for the addition of two district court judges.

WHEREAS, 3.38.10 RCW establishes the district court districting committee, and

WHEREAS, 3.38.20 RCW assigns the responsibility of determining the number of district court judges to be elected in each district, and

WHEREAS, the 1991 Adopted Appropriation Ordinance added two additional district court judges, and

WHEREAS, 3.38.040 RCW provides that the district court districting committee may meet for the purposes of amending the districting plan at any time on call of the county legislative authority, and

WHEREAS, 3.38.040 RCW requires that districting plan amendments be submitted to the county legislative authority by March 15 of each year, and

WHEREAS, 3.38.040 RCW requires districting plan amendments be adopted no later than May 1st following submission by the districting committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County district court districting committee is requested to meet for the purposes of preparing an amended King County district court districting plan that would provide for a total of twenty six district court judges, if such additional judge is authorized by the legislature. To facilitate the quickest possible addition of a twenty-fifth judge, which position is already authorized by RCW 3.34.020, the districting committee may submit its amendments to the districting plan in two stages, with the first stage plan providing for the twenty-fifth judge, and the second stage providing for the twenty-
