4 Career Alternatives, which has provided no-
5 cost career guidance services since 1979.

6 WHEREAS, the Center for Career Alternatives (CCA) is a non-
7 profit human service organization that has successfully
8 provided no-cost employment, training and career guidance
9 services to over 5,000 residents of King and Snohomish County
10 since 1979, and

11 WHEREAS, CCA has consistently placed over 80% of its
12 participants in jobs with over 350 local businesses, adhering
13 to the philosophy that positive community growth is achieved by
14 strengthening economic development, education, and family life,
15 and

16 WHEREAS, CCA is at the forefront of the employment and
17 training field thanks to the many volunteers and employees who
18 provide ongoing support to the program and its participants,
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the commitment and dedication of CCA volunteers
21 and employees is reflected in the numerous awards the
22 organization has received, including the National Job Training
23 Partnership Act (JTPA) Award, the Presidential Summer Jobs
24 Program Award, the Governor's Award for Distinguished Volunteer
25 Service and the United Way Crystal Award, and

26 WHEREAS, these volunteers and employees uphold the values
27 of human rights, equality, and dignity; ensuring that all
28 individuals, regardless of background and experience, have the
29 opportunity to reach their educational and employment goals;

3 to the communities of King County for 11 years, and the
4 individual volunteers and employees are to be honored for their
