MOTION NO. 8211

A MOTION endorsing the principles of Initiative 120 and requesting the Washington State Legislature to enact it into law in the 1991 Session.

WHEREAS, the State of Washington was the first state in the Union to enact through the initiative process a law which protected a woman's right to reproductive privacy, and

WHEREAS, that right was subsequently clarified by the United States Supreme Court in its Roe v. Wade decision, and

WHEREAS, more than 218,000 people from this state signed Initiative 120 which could place the Roe v. Wade protections in state statute, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature has the power to enact the provisions of Initiative 120;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council endorses the principles of Initiative 120 and urges the Washington State Legislature to enact it into law during the 1991 Session.
