WHEREAS, the Watershed Management Committee was formed pursuant to WAC 400-12 and has, along with technical staff from many different agencies, produced the Green-Duwamish Watershed Nonpont Action Plan, and

WHEREAS, the effectiveness of the Plan depends upon cooperation among the numerous jurisdictions within the watershed, and

WHEREAS, the King County Executive and his Departments have reviewed and concurred with recommendations for County actions, and
