

Motion No. 8233

A MOTION approving the Agreement to Enter
Into a Stipulated Order on Medical Issues
at the King County Correctional Facility.

WHEREAS, King County entered into negotiations in order to
resolve issues in litigation concerning health care at the King
County Correctional Facility, and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and Council desire to
achieve accreditation from the National Commission on
Correctional Health Care for health services at the King County
Correctional Facility and have undertaken efforts to achieve
accreditation including the approval of over \$1,000,000 for
staff and resources through the adoption of ordinances 9503
(June 1990), 9762 (October 1990), and 9720 (December 1990), and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Agreement to Enter Into a
Stipulated Order on Medical Issues will allow King County to
resolve the health care issues in litigation and to meet the
aforementioned standards for health care;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Agreement to Enter Into Stipulated Order on Medical
Issues, signed by the parties to the agreement on February 27,
1991, is hereby approved.
