2 A MOTION endorsing the efforts of Pacific
3 Northwest Seattle 1994 in bringing World
4 Cup soccer competition to the Seattle area.

5 WHEREAS, the United States will host the 1994 World Cup,
6 the world's largest sports spectacle, for 30 days in June and
7 July of 1994, and

8 WHEREAS, 24 countries will play 52 soccer matches in as
9 many as 12 different locations throughout the United States for
10 the coveted World Cup trophy, and

11 WHEREAS, 1994 will be the first year the event has been
12 held outside Europe, Central or South America, and

13 WHEREAS, hosting a match in the Puget Sound region would
14 bring exciting inter-cultural soccer team competition to the
15 Seattle area, and

16 WHEREAS, Pacific Northwest Seattle 1994, a non-profit
17 corporation, has been designated by World Cup USA 1994 to
18 submit a proposal for use of the University of Washington Husky
19 Stadium for several of the World Cup matches, and

20 WHEREAS, World Cup soccer competition in the Husky Stadium
21 would be a prestigious and enjoyable event for local citizens
22 and international visitors;

23 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
24 The Husky Stadium at the University of Washington is an ideal
25 location for the 1994 World Cup and the possibility of hosting
26 matches in the Seattle area is a unique and exciting
27 opportunity to express our universal goals with the world
28 community.

1 BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

2 The Council supports and endorses the efforts of Pacific
3 Northwest Seattle 1994 in its bid to bring the 1994 World Cup
4 soccer competition to the Husky Stadium.
