2 A MOTION authorizing the King County
3 executive to enter into agreements with
4 the Washington State Department of
5 Ecology regarding the joint funding of
6 comprehensive flood control studies and
7 maintenance of flood control facilities.

8 WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature created the Flood
9 Control Assistance Account Program (FCAAP) for joint funding of flood
10 control maintenance projects and related comprehensive flood control
11 management plans pursuant to R.C.W. 86.26 and WAC 173-145, and

12 WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology is authorized
13 by the above legislation to administer the sum of four million dollars
14 each biennium for flood control maintenance projects and related com-
15 prehensive flood control management plans, and

16 WHEREAS, R.C.W. 86.26 and WAC 173-145 provide that grants will be
17 available to counties, cities, and other public bodies for up to fifty
18 percent of project planning, design, and construction costs for main-
19 tenance projects, up to eighty percent of emergency projects, and up
20 to seventy-five percent of comprehensive flood control management plan
21 costs, and

22 WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology has invited
23 eligible counties to submit proposals for FCAAP fund grants for the
24 1991-1993 biennium, and

25 WHEREAS, the surface water management division of the King County
26 department of public works has identified the need for detailed
27 floodplain studies in the Snoqualmie, Cedar, and Skykomish River
28 Basins, which experience severe and repeated flooding which threatens
29 the life, health, and property of King County residents, and damages
30 King County facilities including roads, bridges, levees, and
31 revetments;

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The county executive is hereby authorized to develop and sub-
mit to the Washington State Department of Ecology proposals for the

1 Snoqualmie River, Cedar River, and Skykomish River Comprehensive Flood
2 Control Management Plans described in attachment A.

3 B. The county executive is hereby authorized to submit FCAAP
4 grant applications on behalf of the cities of Normandy Park, Issaquah,
5 Seattle, and Bellevue in accordance with FCAAP funding guidelines pro-
6 vided by the Washington State Department of Ecology.

7 C. The county executive is hereby authorized to negotiate agree-
8 ments with the Washington State Department of Ecology to accept grant
9 funding for activities and facilities receiving final offers of finan-
10 cial assistance for the 1991-1993 biennium from the Washington State
11 Department of Ecology.
