A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$682,336 in 1991 to support funding for the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for the Seattle-King County Region.

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology is authorized to make grants of funds under Chapter 70.105D RCW and Engrossed Substitute House Bill 2390 to support implementation of local moderate risk waste plans, and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the preservation and promotion of public health that hazardous wastes not be commingled with other solid wastes nor placed into sewage disposal systems, and

WHEREAS, that enhanced public education and enforcement of existing regulations will reduce the quantity of hazardous wastes entering the regular solid waste stream and sewage disposal systems, and

WHEREAS, the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for Seattle-King County was adopted by all King County jurisdictions and approved by the Department of Ecology, and

WHEREAS, the council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$227,445 in cash contributions in 1991; \$389,456 in 1992; and \$412,824 in 1993; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$682,336 to the Washington State Department of Ecology to support implementation of the Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for the Seattle-King County Region.
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
