MOTION NO. 8300

A MOTION requesting the Executive to prepare and implement a process to refund the \$15 local option motor vehicle registration fee to eligible senior citizens, as allowed by Engrossed Substitute House Bill 2151.

WHEREAS, on December 10, 1990 the county council passed Ordinance No. 9735 establishing a vehicle license fee for the purpose of funding general transportation improvements, and

WHEREAS, the county council heard testimony requesting an exemption to the vehicle license fee for low income senior citizens, and

WHEREAS, the 1991 Legislature has passed Engrossed Substitute House Bill (ESHB) 2151 which allows counties to develop and initiate a refund process of the fifteen dollar vehicle license fee to a vehicle owner sixty-one years of age or older and whose income is eighteen thousand dollars or less or who has a physical disability; and


WHEREAS, ESHB 2151 becomes effective on July 31, 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is requested to prepare a budget and an ordinance to implement the senior citizen motor vehicle registration fee refund pursuant to the provisions of ESHB 2151 and transmit that budget and ordinance to the King County council no later than July 15, 1991.
