A MOTION approving amendments, incorporating 1991 funding, to the 1990 public defense contracts for legal services and authorizing the county executive to accept a grant award of \$40,000 to support indigency representation for dependency proceedings, Grant File No. 111/61.

WHEREAS, King County Code 2.60.040 requires county council approval of legal services contracts negotiated by the office of public defense, and

WHEREAS, legal services agreements were approved in 1990 for a two-year period, the funding was provided for 1990 only, and provision of funds for 1991 requires amendment of the legal services agreements, and

WHEREAS, King County is required by RCW chapter 13.34 to provide representation of indigent persons in dependency proceedings, and does so through the legal services contracts, and

WHEREAS, the 1989 Washington State legislature appropriated funds to the Washington Department of Community Development to provide representation to indigent persons in dependency proceedings under RCW chapter 13.34, and

WHEREAS, the Washington Department of Community Development has awarded a grant to King County, which has been included in the 1991 budget of the office of public defense, and reflected in the legal services contracts with the Society of Counsel Representing Accused Persons and The Defender Association;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County council authorizes and approves the amendments to the legal services contracts of Associated Counsel for the Accused, Northwest Defenders Association, Society of Counsel Representing Accused Persons, and The Defender Association;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to accept an award of funds in the amount of \$40,000 from the Washington Department of Community Development for provision of legal representation to indigent parents and guardians in dependency proceedings on behalf of King County;
