A MOTION expressing the intention of the King County Council to place a bond issue or levy for a new jail/regional justice center on the ballot in 1992.

WHEREAS, the county executive has proposed a September, 1992 ballot for a bond issue or levy for a new jail/justice center facility, and

WHEREAS, the county council desires that a site for a new facility be identified prior to the placement of a bond issue or levy for the facility on the ballot, and

WHEREAS, site work and mitigation costs will not be known until the selection of a specific site, and

WHEREAS, the environmental review process will not allow a site for the facility to be selected before April, 1992, and

WHEREAS, the planning and site selection process for the facility will not be delayed by a later vote on the bond issue or levy;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The King County council hereby states its intention to place a bond issue or levy for a new jail/regional justice center on the ballot in 1992.
