A MOTION requesting the Executive to negotiate an interlocal agreement for establishment of a subregional transportation planning steering committee in the south county area.

WHEREAS, since 1986 there has been an interjurisdictional steering committee including representatives of the cities of Auburn, Renton, Tukwila, Kent, and SeaTac; METRO; the Puget Sound Council of Governments; King County; and the private sector working toward development of a south county Transportation Benefit District (TBD); and

WHEREAS, that TBD steering committee has recommended to the King County council that a TBD be formed pursuant to Chapter 36.73 RCW; and

WHEREAS, the King County council has held public hearings on the proposal to form a TBD and has heard from the public that there is not sufficient public support at this time to form a TBD; and

WHEREAS, the King County council acknowledges that there remains an unmet need for additional transportation services in the south county and supports continuation of a multijurisdictional transportation planning process in the south county area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Executive is requested to negotiate and transmit to
the Council for approval an interlocal agreement with the
cities of Auburn, Kent, Tukwila, Renton and SeaTac to create a
steering committee for the purposes of coordinating
transportation plans in the south county area sponsoring a
financing study to analyze the unmet transportation needs in
the south county area and alternatives for financing a portion

of those needs. The agreement should provide for the steering committee to recommend to the King County Council and the other 2 jurisdictions how additional transportation needs in that area 3 4 should be financed.
