A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$100,000 to support in part the preparation of the 1992 King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan.

WHEREAS, King County is required by R.C.W. 70.95 to update a coordinated comprehensive solid waste management plan which will guide development of solid waste management plans and programs in King County and will include the estimated long-range needs for solid waste facilities projected twenty years into the future, and

WHEREAS, King County is required by K.C.C. 10.24.020 and by the Solid Waste Interlocal Agreement to update a coordinated comprehensive solid waste management plan every three years, and

WHEREAS, The Hazardous Waste Cleanup Act provides for the award of grants by the Department of Ecology for solid waste planning, and \$100,000 of the available grant funds have been set aside for use by class AA counties, and

WHEREAS, the council of King County recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$100,000 in cash and/or direct services as a match in support of the project, and

WHEREAS, the \$100,000 match for the grant shall be met through 1991 appropriated expenditure authority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$100,000 to the Department of Ecology for the 1992 King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan on behalf of King County.
- B. The Department of Ecology is hereby assured of full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
