A MOTION requesting the Office of the Prosecuting Attorney to appeal, pursuant to RCW 36.93.160, the decision of the King County Boundary Review Board approving two proposed annexations to the City of Black Diamond, BRB No. 1698 ("Black Diamond Associates") and BRB No. 1699 ("Palmer Coking Coal).

WHEREAS, the King County Boundary Review Board on August 22, 1991 approved two annexations to the City of Black Diamond (Black Diamond Associates, BRB File #1698 and Palmer Coking Coal Company, BRB #1699), and

WHEREAS, the proposed annexations are inconsistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan, by authorizing annexation of rural and resource lands, and

WHEREAS, the proposed annexations are inconsistent with the 1990 and 1991 Growth Management Acts, in that boundaries for urban areas are to be established by counties, and the annexations are not inside existing urban growth areas, nor within areas currently under negotiation for such designation between King County and the City of Black Diamond, and

WHEREAS, the Boundary Review Board failed to fairly and reasonably apply the criteria set out in RCW 36.93 for the approval of annexations;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
The prosecuting attorney is requested to initiate legal action
